Why Two Gospels?

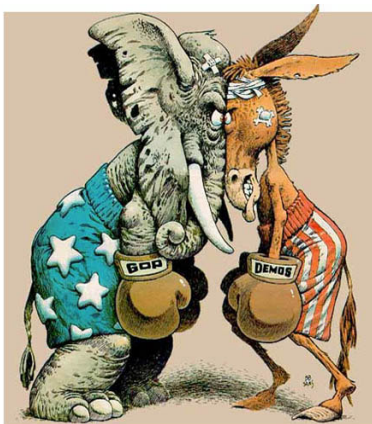

What a Revelation!

In 1 Corinthians 15:51, the apostle Paul writes, “Lo! A secret to you am I telling!” He follows with a description of the snatching away of the saints to heaven, the first humans to be made immortal since the Lord, Jesus Christ. It is fashionable in certain circles to “pooh-pooh” this eclectic resurrection and make it the same as the well-publicized “second coming of Christ,” as prophesied by Daniel (Dan. 12:2). But wait. If Paul’s revelation was a secret, then the snatching away of the saints to heaven cannot be the same revelation spoken by Daniel. *That resurrection was already known!*

Q&A

2 Timothy 2:10 disturbs my peace. This verse says, “If we are disowning, He also will be disowning us.” I thought I couldn’t lose my salvation.

You can’t. Read the verse before this one: “Faithful is the saying: ‘For if we died together, we shall be living together also; if we are enduring, we shall be reigning together also.’” These are two different statements. The “if we died together, we shall be living together also,” refers to eonian life. We *did* die together with Christ (Romans 6:3-11), so we *shall* be living together with Him. The second statement, “if we are enduring, we shall be reigning,” refers, obviously, to reigning. Not everyone who has eonian life, reigns. If we disown Him, He will also disown us—for *reigning*. We’re still saved. Concerning salvation, “He is remaining faithful—He cannot disown Himself. (verse 12).”
